Directions to the Runnin Brand From Georgia on Hwy 411 South, the track is 12 miles inside the Alabama stateline on the left. Coming from Centre, AL on Hwy 411 North, the track is 3.3 miles from the intersection of Hwy 9 and Hwy 411, the track is on the right. Look for the sign. Rules

1. ABSOLUTELY No pit riding . No ATVs, No minibikes, and No golfcarts, NONE. We want our pit area safe and fun for everyone and this is the only way to achieve that. So obey or have your throttle cable cut, worse yet, be escorted to the front gate.
2. Enter the track through staging only, Exit the track after the finish line only.
3. Every racer must have his/hers bike numbered front, left, and right side panels to be scored properly. This is your responsibility. In the event two riders have the same number, the second rider with the same number will be asked to add a number or letter.
4. At rider registration, you will receive staging dots that are numbered. You will be asked to show these numbers in staging to be able to race and or get on the track for practice.

Very important, we require that all spectators and racers that are not racing must keep off the track at all times and stay behind the fences. This is for the safety of you and your family. If a fellow racer needs your help out on the track, you must have permission, you can ONLY get this permission from John Garmon. He will be at the staging area/ starting line or ask a track employee to raise him on the radio. Thanks for your cooperation on this.

A reminder, Cherokee County is a dry county, that means no alcohol, none. Not at the track, not outside the track, please obey this law. If everyone will comply with these simple rules there is no reason that everyone can't have a safe and fun time here at our Ranch.

Times

Centre, Alabama goes by Central Time.

Gate opens at sun up and closes at 10:00 PM

Racers sign-up: 5:30 AM – 7:45 AM

Practice starts at: 7:30 AM – 8:45 AM

Riders Meeting: 9:00 AM sharp *Be ready to race shortly thereafter, our riders meeting is short.*

Fees

Gate Fees: Adults \$10.00 / 6yr. old and under is FREE

Pre – Registration Every racers first entry fee is \$35.00, second entry fee \$30.00, each additional entry fee is \$30.00. Payment to be received by specified deadlines on Registration form, this can be done by a personal check, company check, or money order.

Post Registration Every racers first entry fee is \$40.00, second entry fee \$35.00, each additional entry fee is \$35.00. Payment on race day is CASH ONLY, no exceptions.
